



Ganny Lock Knit-A-Long – Part 3

Welcome to the Baa Baa Brighthouse Ganny Lock Knit-A-Long! Ganny Lock is a crescent shaped shawl knitted from the top down.

YOU WILL NEED

1 x 100g Baa Baa Brew DK (pictured in Woodhouse)

1 x 100g Baa Baa Brew DK (pictured in Rastrick)

A pair of 4mm knitting needles (Ganny Lock can be knitted on straight needles but circular needles may be more comfortable to accommodate the large number of stitches as the shawl progresses).

MEASUREMENTS

Ganny Lock Shawl 132cm x 32cm at its widest and longest points.

TENSION

28rs x 22sts – 10cm / 4”sq approx.

ABBREVIATIONS

k	knit	p	purl
k2tog	knit the next 2 stitches together	ws	wrong side
st	stitch	rs	rows
yo	yarn over	approx	approximately
kfb	knit into the front and back of next stitch		

Ganny Lock Knit-A-Long Part Three

Change to first colour

Row 11: K2, (yo) twice, kfb in next st, k to last 4 sts, kfb in next st, k1, (yo) twice, k2.

Row 12: K3, p to last 3sts, k3

Repeat rows 11 and 12 four more times, alternating the colour every two rows to create stripes. Carry the dropped yarn up the side of your work so there are fewer ends to weave in when the shawl is finished.
