



Baa Baa Bunting – Red, White & Blue



You will need:

300g DK Yarn

(For this project I used 3 skeins of Sirdar Cotton DK in Galore Red, Mill White and Sailor Blue. It's a good idea to use a cotton based yarn if you're planning to hang your bunting outside, as it will withstand inclement weather and not lose its shape like wool).

6mm Knitting Needles

Pattern:

Cast on 4sts.

Row 1: K 1 row.

Row 2: K1, M1, K until you have 1st on left needle, M1, K1. 6sts.

Row 3: K 1 row.

Row 4: K1, M1 (YF, K2tog), repeat until you have 1st on left needle, M1, K1. 8sts.

Row 5: K 1 row.

Cast off.

Weave in ends.

Making Up:

The pattern forms one triangle of bunting. Repeat as many times as you wish in each colour. Weave each triangle onto a length of thin satin ribbon. Sew each triangle of bunting in place to prevent them sliding together. Sew a button between each for decoration. I used buttons from a selection of vintage style ones I already had in my sewing box.
